Digital Learning Centre Inauguration

The centre serves as a platform for educational advancement and digital empowerment.

Food Donation Initiative

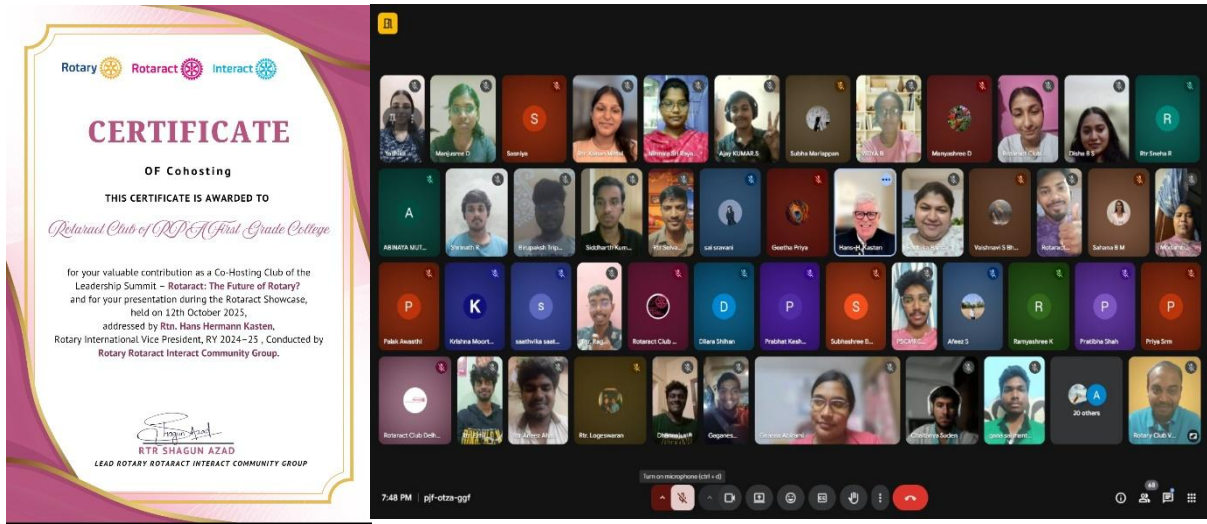
Peace Run
